

## Trash and Recycle Schedule Changes

In 2009, Howard County moved to a "Holiday Slide Schedule". When a major holiday falls on a weekday, ALL trash, recycle, and yardwaste collections after that day will slide to the next day in the week. For 2010, that means that our normal Tuesday/Friday pick-ups will change for the following holidays:

Memorial Day Wednesday June 2nd

Saturday June 5<sup>th</sup>

**Labor Day** Wednesday Sep 8<sup>th</sup>

Saturday Sep 11<sup>th</sup>

**Thanksgiving** Saturday Nov 27<sup>th</sup>
