Dumpster Deposits

The dumpsters will be parked on Summer Home Terrace and Latchlift Court over the weekend of April 24th-25th .

This activity is organized for our community only, and we are legally and financially responsible for any unacceptable items found in the containers, or for any items that overflow the top of the container or that are left outside the container.

Large items can be placed inside the container by opening up the latch on the back door- but please remember to close the latch securely when you are finished with your "deposit".

Items allowed in the containers include:

- Furniture
- Small appliances
- Carpets and padding
- Equipment, tools
- Playground equipment
- Mattresses
- Bicycles
- Shelving

Sorry, but the following can NOT be accepted:

- Household trash
- Household chemicals or cleaners
- Liquids or oils of any kind
- Propane or compressed gas tanks
- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners
- Medical waste
- Paint or paint cans
- Asbestos
- Tires
- Poisons, caustics, acids, solvents.
- Garden chemicals or fertilizers
- Ammunition, explosives, or firearms
- Drum containers, fuel or oil tanks
- Creosoted timber
- · Coals or ashes
- · Batteries of any kind
- Soil, rocks, or boulders
- Large volume of remodeling or construction waste
- Recyclables— newspapers, bottles, cans, yard waste or any items normally collected on recycling day
