Architectural Committee Updates

Spring Maintenance Tips

With Spring quickly approaching, the Architectural Committee would like to share some Spring home maintenance tips.

- 1. Cleaning outside home surfaces 2018 was one of the top 10 wettest years in Maryland history and as a result most of our homes have developed a build-up of dirt and mildew. A pressure washer is the perfect tool to remove this debris. This is also a good time to inspect surfaces and replace any damage. For homes with aluminum siding, please be careful with pressure washers since aluminum siding is easily damaged. Use a low pressure setting or consult a professional.
- 2. Roof Inspection Look for spots on your roof that need fixing to prevent damage inside your home and for signs that is time to replace your roof (bald/cracked/curled shingles, dark streaks).
- 3. Gutter Cleaning Clogged gutters open your home to water damage. Having your gutters inspected at least twice a year is recommended.
- 4. Clean and Repair Screens Spring is a good time to clean your window screens and inspect them for damage. Screens can be cleaned by gently scrubbing them with soap and water. Holes on the screen can be patched using a screen repair kit.
- 5. Driveway and Sidewalks Inspect your asphalt and/or concrete surfaces for cracks. Repairing these cracks can prevent further damage to these surfaces. Consider having asphalt driveways resurfaced. We also ask that you power wash sidewalks and front porches.
- 6. Paint Inspect your home's painted surfaces for cracked or peeling paint. Not only does a good paint job make your home look nice, it also prevents damage to the underlying surface.
- 7. Tree and shrub pruning and grooming along with fresh mulching of flower beds

Dear GABLES Homeowner,

This is your notice of the 2019 Annual Assessment for The GABLES.

(Please refer to Section 3 of the G.A.L.H. Articles of Incorporation, and Section 6 of the Declaration of Covenants.)

The GABLES' Annual Assessment for 2019 is \$375.

Your Annual Assessment payment is due February 28, 2019. However, consistent with the 2018 assessment

- an early-payment discount of \$25 (net \$350) applies to dues that are paid before the end of January;
- the full amount of \$375 is due for payments made after Jan. 31st but before Feb. 28th; and
- as provided for under the Declaration of Covenants, a \$20 late fee penalty is assessed along with additional fees (calculated as monthly increments of a 20%-per-year interest charge) on all payments made after February 28th.

*Please note, the payment must be post-marked by the due date for the early discount or on-time payment.

The detailed payment timetable for 2019 dues is as follows:

Please note that \$5 per month interest will continue to accrue until payment is made. These dues are not covered by your mortgage escrow, and are directly payable by you.

Loaded Texas Dip



Loaded Texas Trash dip is the classic warm bean dip that gets loaded with corn, olives, black beans, and ooey gooey cheese! This dip will be the hit at your next party!

Ingredients

- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese
- 1 cup sour cream
- 2 cans (16 ounces each) refried beans
- 1 can (15 ounce) black beans
- 1 can (15 ounce) corn
- 1 can (3.8 ounce) sliced black olives
- 1 can (4½ ounces) chopped green chilies, drained
- 1 package McCormick® Taco Seasoning Mix
- 4 cups shredded Mexican cheese blend, divided

I sometimes add a lb. of lean ground beef

Optional toppings, chopped cilantro, cherry tomatoes, sliced avocado Instructions

Preheat oven to 350°F. Microwave cream cheese and sour cream in large microwaveable bowl on high 1 minute or until cheese is softened. Remove from microwave. Mix with wire whisk until smooth. Add refried beans, black beans, corn, black olives, green chilies, Seasoning Mix and 2 cups of the cheese; mix well.

Spread bean mixture into 13x9-inch baking dish sprayed with no stick cooking spray. Sprinkle with remaining 2 cups cheese.

Bake 25 minutes or until cheese is melted. Serve with tortilla chips.
