### Yard Care Tips

#### How to Kill Vines - Removing the Vines Manually

If you have vines growing up trees in yard (this can eventually kill the tree) below are some solutions To kill the vines.

Cover up to protect your skin from the vines.  
Pry away climbing vines from trees or buildings with a sturdy, flat tool. Cut away vines with pruning shears or a pruning saw.  
Pull or dig the base of the vines out of the ground by hand.  
Mow vines growing on the ground to kill them easily.

## Egg Noodles with Cabbage



This is a recipe from my mother use to make. It's cabbage that is lightly browned in butter and mixed with egg noodles and eggs browned lightly for a wonderful, hearty, and fast dish

### Ingredients

#### Ingredient Checklist

- 1 (16 ounce) package egg noodles
- 1 stick butter
- 1 medium head green cabbage, chopped
- 1 medium yellow onion
- 3 eggs
- ¼ cup of milk
- salt and pepper to taste

### Directions

#### Instructions

##### Step 1

Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Cook the egg noodles in the boiling water until the pasta is tender yet firm to the bite, about 5 minutes. Drain.

##### Step 2

While the noodles cook, melt the butter in a large skillet over low heat. Add the cabbage and onion to the melted butter; season with salt and pepper. Cover and cook until the cabbage begins to brown, 5 to 7 minutes. Stir the drained noodles into the cabbage; scramble milk and eggs together in a bowl then pour over noodles and cabbage then cook and stir until the noodles begin to brown, about 5 minutes.
