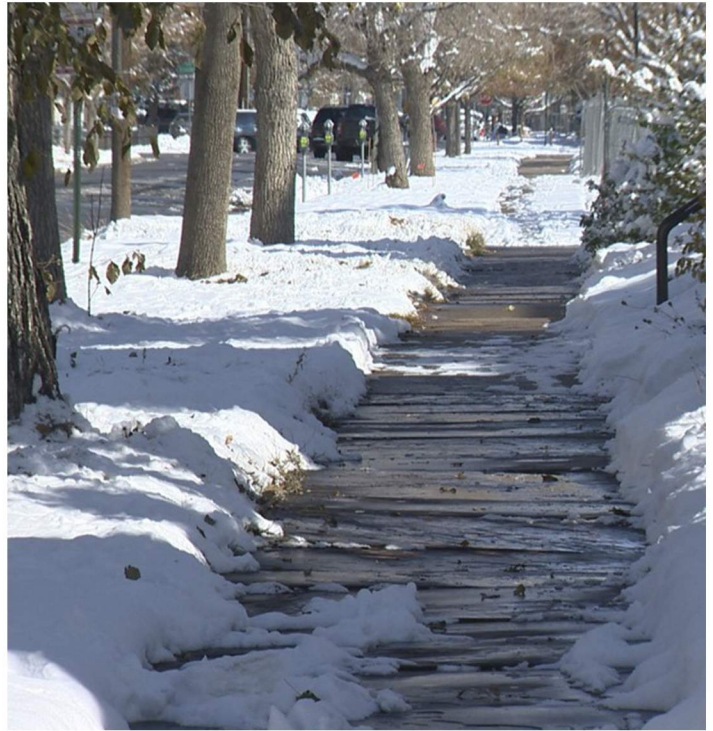


## LET IT SNOW, LET IT SNOW!

The Community asks that neighbors are considerate of their neighbors and pull cars off the roadways and cul-de-sacs during snow events so plows and salt trucks can get through the neighborhood. Clear roads mean we can travel in and out of our community freely. We also want clear roads in case emergency vehicles need to get through.

The GALH has hired a contractor to remove snow and ice on our community sidewalks. For neighbors who have sidewalks in front of their houses, you are responsible for removing the snow within 48 hrs. (This is a Howard County Law). The Architectural committee asked the Board to approve some ice melt for the sitting area sidewalk which sometimes gets icy after melt and refreeze. We also have placed another ice melt container by the doggy poo station on Summer Home.

Please look for the brown container with the blue shovel close to the dog waste can and a white bucket with blue shovel by the sitting area.

## INGREDIENTS

10 oz Frozen Spinach,  
thawed & squeezed dry  
6 oz Cream Cheese,  
softened  
1 tsp minced Garlic  
1/2 tsp Salt  
1/2 tsp Onion Powder  
1/4 tsp Pepper  
1/4 tsp Chili Powder  
1 tsp Italian Powder  
1/2 c Grated Parmesan  
1 c Grated Mozzarella  
1 tube Refrigerated Thin  
Crust Pizza Crust  
2 Tbsp Melted Butter

## FOOTBALL SPINACH DIP BREADSTICKS

Looking for the perfect Super Bowl Party Treat? These stuffed breadsticks are always a crowd pleaser!

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees.

2. In a bowl, beat together the spinach and cream cheese. Add garlic, salt, onion powder, pepper, chili powder, Italian seasoning and beat to combine. Add parmesan cheese and 1/2 cup mozzarella cheese and beat to combine.
